Whether you will be home or away please be sure to follow these tips:

Leave thermostat set at 60° or higher, disconnect hoses and cover outside faucets with insulated covers, replace furnace filters several times a year to help with efficiency

When (if) the snow hits our area and reaches a depth of two inches or more we will plow the streets within the housing areas. We do not clear the sidewalks or driveways (residents need to clear their own). The streets leading to housing will be plowed by NAVFAC crews.

LEAVE YOUR THERMOSTAT SET TO 60° TO KEEP PIPES FROM FREEZING

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

OUTDOOR FAUCET COVERS - PUT 'EM ON Winter weather and freezing temperatures will be here before we know it. Help get your home ready for Old Man Winter by disconnecting hoses and covering outside faucets with insulated covers. If you don't already have a faucet cover handy, come on down to the maintenance shop - we've got them for free! And, help ensure your furnace is operating at tip-top shape by replacing filters often. Not only does replacing the filter help your furnace run more efficiently it can also help reduce maintenance issues. Free furnace filters are available at maintenance. If you plan on being away from home during these chilly months be sure to leave heat set to 60° to help avoid returning home to frozen/busted pipes.

HOLIDAY DECORATING/LIGHTING

We want all of our residents to enjoy living here and adding a personal touch by decorating for the holidays is one way to help make your house a home.

Any lights or decorations attached to the home must not cause any physical damage. Gutter clips or similar devices are required for affixing exterior lighting; nails, screws, etc. are prohibited. Roof decorations and lighting above the first floor roofline are not permitted. Resident will be required to immediately remove such decorations when discovered. Canned "snow" or other similar substances must not be sprayed on windows, siding or brick facades.

Holiday lighting is only allowed from Thanksgiving until the second weekend in January, between 5PM and 10PM. Holiday lighting must be turned off when you are not home. Please remove lighting and holiday decorations by the weekend of **January the 13th**.

Total Landscaping will pick up live trees that are free of tinsel, frocking and decorations and placed curbside on **January 8, 2019**.
