# **COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS**

### **Holiday Decorations**

Holiday Decorations are permitted between Thanksgiving Day and the second weekend in January. Decorative lighting for other time periods may be installed/displayed one week prior to the holiday and removed no later than three (3) days after the holiday.

- Canned "snow" or other similar substances must not be sprayed on windows/siding.
- Any lights or decorations attached to the premises must not cause any physical damage. Gutter clips or similar clip devices are required for affixing exterior lighting; nails/screws/tacks are not permitted.

### **Absence from Residence**

Please notify the office if you will be out of town for over 7 days.

### **Freezing temperature Advisories**

- Disconnect garden hoses to prevent pipes from bursting.
- Let faucets drip when temperatures drop below 32 degrees.
- Please keep the thermostat set to no lower than 65 degrees.


