
GOOD NEWS STORY!

COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

As spring is approaching, we wanted to remind everyone of a few common compliance items.

- Holiday decoration Must be removed at this time.
- · Vehicle Maintenance (including washing the car) -
- Lawn care Must be below 5", lawn mowers & weed whackers are available for check out for free. Contact the maintenance team to check one out.
- Trampolines Not permitted without prior written approval.
- Garage Window Coverings Are not permitted.
- **Gazebos** Decorative, free-standing patio furnishing type canopies are okay, tarps and pop-up style canopies are not permitted.
- **AC Units** Must be portable style, window mounted units are not permitted without an exception to policy for ground floor only.
- Fire Pits/Tiki Torches/Propane heaters Are not allowed.
- **BBQ** Must be used at least (10) feet from the house/ fence/carport and should not be left unattended when in use or while still hot. We require Residents to properly dispose of coals.
- **Pet Waste** Must be picked up after each occurrence, both in the yard and in the community.
- **Decorative Patio Lighting** Is not permitted, freestanding battery-operated lights are okay.
- **RV Parking** Is not permitted. Can be on property for 2HRS for loading and unloading only.
- Quiet Hours 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.
- **Clutter** Please properly dispose of trash and remove excess clutter from patios.
- Trash/Litter As a reminder, the trash can is to be pulled out after 6:00 PM the day before trash day and must be out no later than 7:00 AM to ensure pick up. Cans must be pulled back by 8:00 PM on trash day. Please note, excess garbage is billed as an additional cost to the resident.
- Marijuana Usage is not permitted on Federal Property


