lookout for purple balloons scattered around the neighborhood. Those who spot a balloon are asked to snap a photo and tag Hunt Military Communities on Facebook



At Hunt Military Communities, we understand the sacrifices and challenges that military children face daily. In honor of the Month of the Military Child, we've launched our fifth annual "Hunt Little Heroes" program. The initiative is an opportunity for us at HMC to recognize and celebrate military children across the nation who are heroes within their communities. We are asking military children to share their "Hero Story" with us, detailing what they think it takes to be a hero and how they make a difference in their communities. Submissions can be in the form of a 300-word essay or a short video.






