COMMUNITY REMINDERS

COMPLIANCE REMINDERS

- **Marijuana usage** is strictly prohibited on Federal Property and should not be used at any time.
- **Trampolines** are not permitted without prior written approval.
- Gazebos: Decorative, free-standing patio furnishing type canopies are allowed. However, tarps and pop-up style canopies are not permitted.
- Fire Pits/Tiki Torches/Propane Heaters: These items are not allowed on the property.

- BBQs must be used at least 10 feet away from the house, fence, or carport. They should not be left unattended while in use or while still hot.
- Privacy fence covers need to be approved by the office prior to installation.
- RV parking is not permitted. RVs can be on the property for up to 2 hours for loading and unloading only.
- **Clutter**: Residents must properly dispose of trash and remove excess clutter from patios.

Flushable Wipes Reminder

Flushable wipes do not break down properly and can cause plumbing issues. Residents may be charged for any damages resulting from improper disposal.

A/C Units

With the warmer weather approaching, please be mindful of how many A/C units and other electronics are being used in your home. Overloading circuit breakers can occur if multiple units and devices are plugged in simultaneously.

Spiders and other insects are common in the Pacific Northwest, especially during the spring and summer months. If you encounter an infestation, please call pest control at 360-447-5900 to schedule an appointment with pest control.

TRASH/LITTER REMINDERS

- Trash cans can be pulled out after 6:00PM the day before trash day and must be out no later than 7:00AM to ensure pickup.
- Cans must be pulled back by 8:00PM on trash day. Excess garbage is billed as an additional cost to the resident.
