## COMPLIANCE: FOR SAFETY AND WELL-BEING

Living in family housing has its benefits: close proximity to base activities and services as well as creating a real sense of community. But living so close together can have its challenges, too. By following a few simple rules it will help ensure a positive environment for all.

- · Clean up after your pets in your home, in your yard and especially whenever they are in the community. Dogs must be leashed at all times and cannot be left unattended outside and/or tied to common area trees, posts or other fixtures.
- · Winter weather is still a threat. If you plan on being away from your home please ensure you leave heat set to 60° and while home keep your garage door closed to retain as much heat as possible.
- · Help keep the community looking neat and tidy by properly storing your trash and recycling bins by 8:00PM same day as pick-up. Make sure all trash/recycle bins are clearly marked with your address.

# HUNT-PROVIDED RENTER'S INSURANCE TO END JANUARY 31, 2019

As you may be aware from prior notifications, in 2015 the Department of Defense announced a major change that affected your Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH). The Fiscal Year 2015 National Defense Authorization Act eliminated renter's insurance as a component of BAH. Despite the announced change over two years ago, Hunt Military Communities continued to provide renter's insurance (including personal property coverage) for all current residents. Earlier this year, notification of cancellation was sent to all current residents. This is a friendly reminder that the current policy will be provided through January 31, 2019, at which time coverage will end. Hunt Military Communities highly recommends that you purchase your own personal coverage for your household needs. Any future changes to renter's insurance coverage will be in accordance with your resident lease.
